PROTOCOL FOR FILING FOR AN INSURANCE CLAIM

When a registered player, in good standing, is injured during an affiliated game the proper procedure for filing for an insurance claim is below. Please be prepared to provide the following information when calling the office to initiate the claim.

*NAME

*ADDRESS

*PHONE NUMBER

*PLAYER ID NUMBER

*TEAM NAME

*LEAGUE NAME

*DATE OF INJURY

*TYPE OF INJURY

*FIELD LOCATION

The office staff will then verify the player is currently registered and in good standing with the WSASA. Once that is established, the office will send out a claim form to be completed by the player and sent back to the WSASA office. The office then verifies the additional information and forwards the claim form to the insurance company. After this, the insurance company will be in direct contact with the player. The process can take several weeks to complete because claims for all players in the United States are being processed by a limited number of insurance representatives.

This insurance is a secondary policy It will only take the primary position if the injured player does not have medical insurance. There is a \$400.00 deductible which must be satisfied before the insurance company begins covering expenses. There is a \$10,000.00 policy limit.
