PROTOCOL FOR FILING FOR AN INSURANCE CLAIM

When an affiliated player in good standing is injured during an affiliated game the proper procedure for filing for an insurance claim form is as follows:

The player must call the WSSA Office (425) 485-7855 with

- * NAME
- * ADDRESS
- * PHONE NUMBER
- * PLAYER ID NUMBER
- * TEAM NAME
- * LEAGUE NAME
- * DATE OF INJURY
- * TYPE OF INJURY
- * FIELD LOCATION

The office staff will then verify that the player is currently registered and in good standing with the WSSA. Once that is established the office will send out a claim form to be completed by the player and sent back to the WSSA office. The office then verifies the additional information and forwards the claim on to the insurance company. At this point the insurance company will be in direct contact with the player. The process can take time as there is one person doing the claims for all players in all the states.

The insurance is a secondary insurance which becomes a primary carrier if the player does not have a primary insurance. There is a \$400 deductible which must be paid by the player and a \$5000 limit.
